

ENTERPRISE CARSHARE THROUGH THE E&I CONTRACT

Enterprise CarShare's membership-based car rental programs provide university students, faculty, and staff 24/7 access to vehicles on campus. Automated vehicle technology allows members to scan into dedicated vehicles and rent for as long as they need – even by the hour. Members pay one low hourly or daily rate that includes fuel, physical damage protection, liability protection, as well as 24/7 member services and roadside assistance.

How to rent:

- Join | Once approved, students can access vehicles on campus with their membership card or through the Enterprise CarShare app
- **Reserve** | Log in, select a vehicle, and indicate how long it is needed. With the Enterprise mobile app, vehicles can be reserved on the go.
- **Unlock and Go** | Swipe the membership card over the windshield sensor or use the mobile app to unlock the vehicle. The keys will be inside.
- **Return** | Return the vehicle to the pickup location and place keys in the glovebox keyholder. Swipe the membership card over the reader one last time or use the mobile app to end the trip, which will lock the doors and end the rental.
