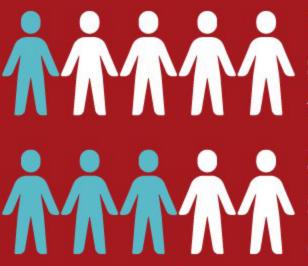

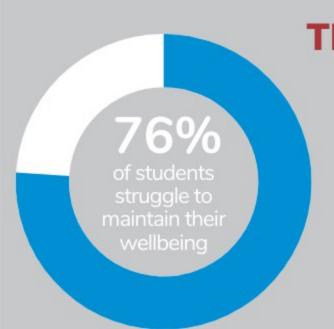


THE EMERGING STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS



1 in 5 college & university **students** experience suicidal

3 in 5 college & university **students** are living with a mental



THE IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Throughout the course of the pandemic, students have had a hard time coping with pandemic-related stress and protecting their mental health, according to a study conducted in over 10 countries including the US, UK, **Netherlands, France, Spain & Australia**

GAPS AND BARRIERS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE

68% of college & university presidents cited "mental health" as their most pressing issue in 2021





However, only 13% of students have used on-campus mental health services since the onset of the pandemic

58% of students report being on some type of waitlist at their college's counseling services

45% of students believe their to be a public stigma around accessing treatment

30% of students are unsure about where to go to seek care for their mental health
